Section 19.82(2), Wisconsin Statutes, states in part as follows:

If one-half or more of the members of a governmental body are present, the meeting is rebuttably presumed to be for the purposes of exercising the responsibilities, authority, power or duties delegated to or vested in the body.

To the extent that four or more members of the School Board actually attend, the above listed meeting may be rebuttably presumed to be a meeting within the meaning of Wisconsin's open meeting law. Notice is, therefore, given. Only the subjects set forth above will be discussed. There will be no votes taken by the Board of Education.
